



New England Bike Park Lift Ticket Reciprocity

2025 summer employees of Berkshire East may ride for free at participating bike parks (see below). Each bike park uses a different process to redeem tickets. Make sure you are prepared with the proper documentation before your travels. When visiting other parks please act professional and represent TMBP to the best of your ability.

Email Grace and Liza for electronic vouchers. Redeem online through Killington's website. Do not request free tickets at the Killington ticket window.



Bring a letter of introduction from HR or your manager and an ID to the ticket office in the Governor's Lodge.



Bring a letter of introduction from HR or your manager and an ID to the Stratton ticket office.



Bring a letter of introduction from HR and an ID, **or** bring a recent pay stub (within two weeks). One family member or friend gets a half off ticket when accompanied by a Berkshire East employee.



Email Grace and Liza for electronic vouchers. Limited supply - first come first serve. We will run out.



Bring a recent paystub (within two weeks)



The employee must present a letter on original letterhead stationery from your home mountain. It must contain the date of intended use and the employee's full name. This letter must be signed by management. Photocopies and altered dates or names will not be accepted.

Visiting employees should present their letters to the guest services desk located in the ticket pavilion at the Westside.

The employee must show identification in the form of valid employee ID or government issued photo identification.

Due to our smaller size and in consideration of our regular guests, no more than 10 employees may receive a reciprocal ticket in a single day without prior authorization from Mt. Abram.
